³⁴ But when the Pharisees heard that He had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together. ³⁵ Then one of them, a lawyer, asked *Him a question*, testing Him, and saying, ³⁶ "Teacher, which *is* the great commandment in the law?" ³⁷ Jesus said to him, " 'You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' ³⁸ This is the first and great commandment. ³⁹ And the second *is* like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' ⁴⁰ On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets."

- 1989 John was an atheist
- 1990 (Fall) Saved and surrendered to the Lordship of Christ/began preparing for ministry
- 1991 (Spring) Called to preach
- 1994 ordained/received vision from God for Kingdom Life Church/discovered Purpose Driven Church book/Travelled throughout denomination teaching PD Church model
- 1995 to '97 introduced to the reality of God's Kingdom
- 1998 worst spiritual desert of my life...almost "lost it"
- 1999 restored from broken fellowship with God
- 2000 to 2002 disciple children at home
- 2002 to 2010 faithfulness test: supporting another man's vision at our last church
- 2010 (Summer) organized Kingdom Life Community
- 2010 (September) began meeting on Sunday mornings
- 2011 (September) officially opened doors of church to the community

The 7 Pillars of Our Ministry Mandates

- I. Pillar #1 Worship (To love God)
 - Real love, the God-kind-of-love is:
 - Unconditional
 - Sacrificial
 - **Selfless**
 - And results in
 - Commitment
 - Investment

Worship is more than an act; it is a way of life!

- 4 ways Kingdom Life Church loves God through our worship:
 - We love God by experiencing the living Word of God
 - We love God by engaging in passionate praise of God
 - God inhabits the praise of His people (Ps. 22:3)
 - We love God by crying out to God in expectant prayer
 - We love God by giving cheerfully unto God our...
 - Time
 - Talent ability
 - Tender finances
- II. Pillar #2 Fellowship (Loving Ourselves and Others)

Acts 2:37-47

³⁷ Now when they heard *this*, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Men *and* brethren, what shall we do?" ³⁸ Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. ³⁹ For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call." ⁴⁰ And with many other words he testified and exhorted them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation." ⁴¹ Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added *to them*. ⁴² And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers. ⁴³ Then fear came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. ⁴⁴ Now all who believed were together, and had all things in common, ⁴⁵ and sold their possessions and goods, and divided them among all, as anyone had need. ⁴⁶ So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart, ⁴⁷ praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved. – NKJV

God manifested 5 visible realities in the early church:

- 1. They were edified
- 2. They were terrified
- 3. God was glorified
- 4. They were unified
- 5. Their numbers were multiplied

Living out a "Get Naked" Church

- > Accept those with whom we worship
- > Affirm those with whom we worship

Koinonia – community, communion, joint participation, sharing and intimacy

Ginosko – intimacy, intercourse, knowing in a deep and personal way

III. Pillar #3 – Go....Outreach Ministry

Acts 1:8

But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." – NKJV

- a. Temple Ministry The household of faith (here)
 - i. All ministry is about "going"
 - 1. Going, preparing, restoring, or sending others to go
- b. Jerusalem the community surrounding the place where we worship
- c. Judea Regional impact
- d. Samaria Nation impact
- e. The uttermost the nations of the world

Purpose: Helping others experience God through our love.

IV. Pillar #4 – Make....Evangelism & Discipleship Ministry

Purpose: Helping others come into vital relationship with God through Jesus Christ.

- a. Witnessing going out specifically to share the gospel of Jesus Christ
- b. Salvation altar ministry, salvation follow-up
- c. Discipleship training toward maturity, mentoring
- d. Restoration helping fallen disciples recover

V. Pillar #5 – Baptize....Membership Development Ministry

Purpose: Helping others assimilate and incorporate into the fabric of our community and the body of Christ.

Everyone is in one of these 5 places (Purpose Driven Church by Rick Warren)

- a. Community un-churched in area surrounding church
- b. Crowd those who eventually attend any service
- c. Congregation members/regular attendees
- d. Committed directed, disciplined, diligent and dedicated maturing disciples (typical source of volunteers)
- e. Core mature disciples and ministry leaders

3 Ways We Help People Get Connected to Kingdom Life Community and the Body of Christ

- Identification Tells others we belong and reminds us that we are family
- Inclusion no one is left out
- Incorporation helping people find our place in the body

VI. Pillar #6 – Teach....Teaching & Training Ministry

Purpose: Helping others come to full maturity so that we can fulfill or God-given purpose.

- a. Truth the truth makes us free
- b. Knowledge the truth only helps us when we know it
- c. Understanding the truth only helps us to the degree we understand it
- d. Wisdom the truth only helps us to the extent that we have the wisdom to apply it
